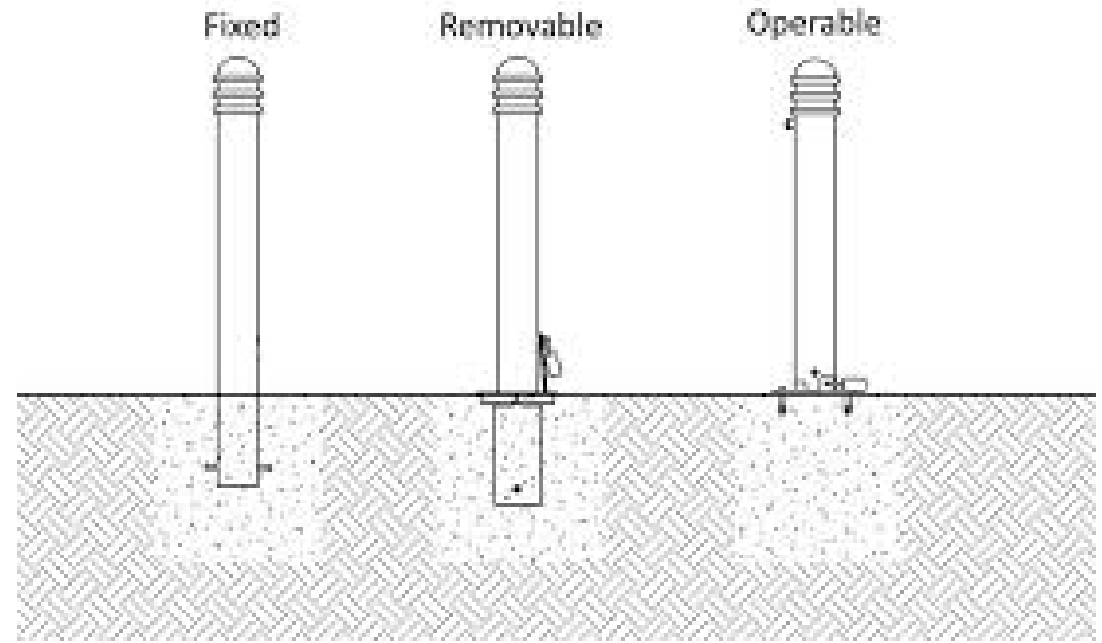
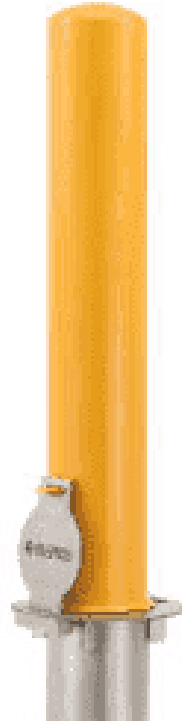

# Bollards

- Requires permit from DOT to place on public property
- Must allow 6ft of space for ADA access
- Private property at operator/owner discretion





## Removeable Bollards

- Removed prior to use of entry/exit
- Behind roll up doors overnight

- Dual purpose

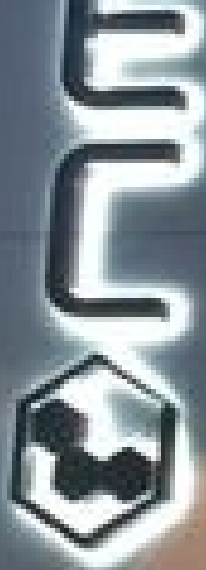

## Recent Trend

---

- Workers followed off site and robbed or vehicle break-ins
- Vehicles conducting static surveillance outside of locations



# Pre-Departure plan

---

- Check exterior cameras for suspicious people vehicles or activity
- Have a guard conduct a foot patrol prior to leaving
- Alter routine periodically





# Counter Surveillance Techniques while driving

---

- The best way to avoid surveillance is by varying your routine and avoiding routes you habitually use.
- Drive slow in the slow lane on freeway
- Pull to the side of the road unexpectedly
- Exit and re-enter the freeway
- Avoid going directly from point A to B
- If you are being followed, call the police and drive to the police station. Tell the dispatcher what going on.
