



Oakland Transit Street Categories

- Low-Frequency (Under 10 buses/hr)



Completed projects

Quick fixes



- Repaved 26 miles of transit streets:
 - MacArthur Blvd from 73rd Ave to 83rd Ave
 - Bancroft Ave from High St to 109th Ave
 - Camden St from Foothill Blvd to Seminary Ave
 - 23rd Ave from Foothill Blvd to E 31st St
 - Foothill Blvd/E 15th St from 1st Ave to 14th Ave
 - College Ave from Broadway to Claremont
- Installed pedestrian lighting on International Blvd between 22nd Ave and Fruitvale Ave
- Line 51 Transit Priority Improvements
- Upgraded numerous bus stops throughout the City

- Tempo Bus Rapid Transit (AC Transit)
- Broadway Transit Lanes from 11th to 20th
- Telegraph Avenue Complete Streets



Planning, programs, & policies



- Preparing [Grand Avenue Mobility Plan](#) (Mandela Parkway to MacArthur Boulevard)
- Working with private developers to install red bus only lanes on 20th Street between Broadway and Telegraph
- Creating a low-income transit pass pilot in West Oakland and upgrading 13 bus stops in West Oakland
- Piloting [Universal Basic Mobility](#) Program in East Oakland
- Updating the City's Bus Shelter Program

 - Telegraph Avenue
 - Grand Avenue
- San Pablo Avenue Corridor Project (ACTC)
 - Phase 1 – Oakland/Emeryville


- Draft Five Year Paving Plan includes repaving 75 miles of transit streets


